Jill Adams Paintings – Portfolio of Northern Cape Raptors

Jill Adams was born in Durban in 1932, but lives most of her life in Kimberley. During this period she worked in close association with one of SA's leading biologists, Dr. Richard Liversidge, as a technical assistant in the Art Dept. of the McGregor Museum. (1974–1983). Jill's major artistic contribution to our natural history was the illustrations (close to 1000) in the recent book *The Birds Around Us* by Richard Liversidge. These illustrations are the product of her outstanding draughtsmanship, coupled with a keen sense of observation and knowledge of the "natural pose" of birds. In order to keep this valuable collection in the Northern Cape, the original paintings were purchased by the Gant family and donated to the McGregor Museum in April 1991. Jill currently lives in Somerset West.
